Key times

CAMPING OPENS	Thursday 17 at 14:00. Glamping check-in from 12:00.
SITE OPEN	09:00 to 04:00 every day, from Friday 18.
MUSIC	Fri 15:00–04:00 · Sat 13:00–04:00 · Sun 13:00–03:00. One stage, no clashes.
WELLNESS	The Pulse tent: activities 09:00–18:00, regulation space 18:00–04:00. Brain Wash, in Góis village: 09:00–18:00.
MARKET AND FOOD	11:00 to 23:00, every day.
BOX OFFICE	Thursday 12:00–00:00 · Friday to Sunday 09:00–00:00. Arriving after midnight? Email us in advance.
LEAVING	Everyone off site by Monday 21 at 12:00. Glamping check-out by 11:00.

ARRIVAL

At the gate

- 18+ only. Bring photo ID. No ID, no entry.
- Your QR ticket is exchanged for an RFID wristband: your ticket, your money and your access. Never take it off.
- There is a quick bag check for everyone.
- Re-entry is free, all weekend.
- Day tickets give site access 09:00 to 04:00 but do not include camping. Every weekend pass does.
- Glamping or Lazy Tent: you receive a glamping wristband at the gate, then head to the glamping welcome reception.
- Lost or damaged wristband: go to the gate or box office and follow the staff's instructions.

MONEY

Cashless

- Bars, food trucks, merch, climbing wall and zip line: all paid with your wristband.
- Top up on site only, at two self-service machines, by contactless card. No cash at the machines.
- The market takes cash. There is no cash machine on site; the nearest is in Góis village, 12 minutes away.
- Reusable cup: €2, no refund. Outside cups are not used.
- Unspent balance refundable until 20 October 2026 via info@chronospherefestival.com, with a €1.50 fee per refund. Top up in small amounts.

GETTING THERE

Travel

THERE ARE NO BUSES ON SATURDAY

No public transport between Coimbra and Góis on Saturday 19, in either direction. Arrive Friday, leave Sunday evening or Monday.

Parking: use the free public car park across the road. It is municipal, so spaces are not guaranteed: arrive early. Accessibility parking is in front of the entrance.

Campervans: free municipal Parque de Pernoita de Autocaravanas, beside the GNR station, 3 minutes' walk.

Carpooling is organised in our Instagram highlights. No festival shuttles this year.

FRI 14:30	Portagem, line 201 direct. Arrives Góis (Beira Rio) 15:51. Best option.
FRI 21:30	Rodoviária, line 201 express (Portagem 21:35). Arrives Góis (Vila) 22:23.
SUN 18:00	Portagem, line 201. Arrives Góis (Vila) 19:22. The only Sunday service in.
BACK SUN	07:30 and 19:00 from Góis (Vila).
BACK MON	06:55 and 16:00 direct to Coimbra. 13:00, 14:20 and 17:40 change at Vila Nova de Poiares.

Stops: Góis (Beira Rio) is a 5-minute walk. Góis (Vila) is 12 minutes. Do not get off at Góis (São Paulo).

Operator BusWay / SIT Região de Coimbra, helpline 707 100 005. Timetables can change, so check before you travel. More connections in the Attendee Handbook and transport guide.

SLEEPING

Camping and glamping

- Camping is included with every weekend pass.
- Glamping and Lazy Tents: book online through WeeZTix, or at the gate subject to availability. Lazy Tents have no sleeping bag, so bring one.
- Toilets and showers are free and open all the time. Showers are cold.
- Phone charging points on site. No lockers.
- No sound systems, speakers or generators in the sleeping areas.

PACKING

Bring

- Warm layers. Hot days, cold and damp nights.
- Swimsuit and towel. Sturdy closed shoes. Sun protection and a hat.
- Refillable water bottle: free water points on site.
- Good earplugs, a power bank, photo ID, a contactless card, and cash for the market.
- Any medication, in its original packaging. A waterproof, just in case.

PACKING

Do not bring

- No fire: no stoves, gas, candles, fireworks or open flame, and no cooking. Smoking is allowed, but butts never go on the ground.
- No glass. No alcohol. Your own food is welcome.
- No cups from home, weapons, drones, sharp objects, pepper spray or laser pens.
- No pets. Assistance dogs only.

Allowed: chairs, parasols, small gazebos and professional cameras (ask before you photograph people).

FOOD AND DRINK

Eating and drinking

- Two bars: one by the stage, one in the wellness area.
- Two food trucks, 11:00–23:00: burgers, hot dogs and chips; kebabs, bifanas and crepes. Both with vegan and gluten-free options.
- The market has local artisans and producers, and some stalls sell snacks.
- Climbing wall and zip line on Saturday and Sunday, €10 each.
- Swim in the Rio Ceira, but no soap, shampoo or detergent ever goes in the water.

SUSTAINABILITY

Leave the valley alone

- Take out or sort everything you bring in, at the separation points.
- Take your tent home. Stay on the marked paths.
- One ticket, one tree, planted with Lousitânea.

ACCESS

Neurodiversity and accessibility

Available to anyone who needs it: no diagnosis, no proof, no explanation.

- Safety Angels around the site all weekend for support, a quiet space or company. Look for the badge.
- Brain Wash regulation space in Góis village, 09:00–18:00. The Pulse tent on site becomes a regulation space 18:00–04:00.
- Reserved space near the stage, with seating. Dedicated deaf and hard-of-hearing area near the stage.
- Staff carry Visual Voice (pictogram communication app) and Spread the Sign (sign dictionary).
- Noise-controlling headphones on site. Accessible toilets and step-free routes where the terrain allows.
- Adapted glamping unit, bookable by email. Free companion tickets with carer documentation.

CONDUCT AND SAFETY

Look after each other

- Consent, every time. Harassment means removal, with no refund.
- No racism, homophobia, transphobia or ableism. Respect the residents of Góis.
- Ask before filming anyone. Never film in the regulation space.
- Any member of staff can help, at any hour. You can report in confidence.
- Medical tent with a doctor, a nurse and a first responder. Nobody will be reported for asking for help.
- Lost and found at the entrance.

IN AN EMERGENCY, CALL 112

Free, from any phone. For anything else, come to the medical tent. The site map, with the medical tent, water points and top-up machines, is sent separately.
